Main Concept: Create two (2) exams. The first one will have the consent question and the second one will be your actual exam.


The second exam, the real final exam that is, will be made available to the student based on what he answers on the first exam. i.e. the Consent.

If any one of you already created your final exams, you don't have to create new ones, just make some setting modifications to the ones you already created.



Creating the Exam


In your Moodle course, click the **gear icon** at the top right of your course page




For the Drop Down menu, Click the **Turn editing on** option



In the week/topic you wish to add it to, click on the +Add an activity or resource link




Form the drop down menu under activities select quiz and then Add




Exam Settings


Name your exam "**Declaration of Consent**" and set the "Timing" settings to be half an hour (30 minutes) before the start of the final exam.




In the "Grade" section, put "100" in the "Grade to pass" field




In the "Review options" make sure that the "Marks" under the "Later, while the quiz is still open" column is selected.



In the "Activity completion" section, make sure the following two fields are selected




Click on "Save and display"




Exam Question

In this case, your examination will be scheduled at a later stage, based on the situation as it will evolve and defined by the conditions caused by the current COVID-19 pandemic.





Click on "Save changes"




Make sure that the "Grade" of the question is "100" and that the "Maximum grade" of the exam is also "100"




Necessary settings in the "real" final exam

Create your final exam as you normally would, or if you have already created one, go to the settings of your exam.

Go to the "Restrict access" section. Click on "Add restriction"




Select the "Activity completion" option




Make sure that the following options are as following:


- 1. "Must"
- 2. "Declaration of consent" i.e. name of the first exam
- 3. "Must be complete with pass grade"



If you are finished with the other settings of your exam, click "Save and return to course"




You can see not that under the final exam says "Not available unless: The activity **Declaration of Consent** is complete and passed"




Allowing a student to change his answer


Click on the "Declaration of Consent"
