The total duration of the program is 4603 hours and includes theoretical teaching of 1624 hours and clinical teaching and practice of 2979 hours, which exceed the provisions of the Nursing and Midwifery law and the European Directive 2013/55/EE.

The clinical training/ practice takes place during the academic semesters and includes teaching and practical training in the Nursing labs of the University and at Hospitals and Clinics.

*Students take the English Placement Test of the University and based on their results they either take the ENH080-English For Health Sciences II or the elective course of ENH070-English For Health Sciences I and students, provided they successfully complete this course, register for the ENH080.
