The first part of the workshop will include exercises with the help of 'impairment goggles', an optical technology which enables the user to simulate the results of alcohol and other substances and experience effects such as destabilization, misrepresentation of reality, reaction time etc.

The second part will explore the truths about substance use and how it can impact people's lives on a bio-psycho-social level and offer the opportunity to discuss the benefits of a drug-free lifestyle.

The session will conclude with a guided relaxation exercise to help participants unwind and reflect.

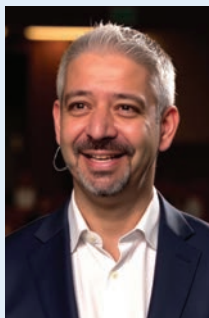

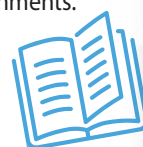

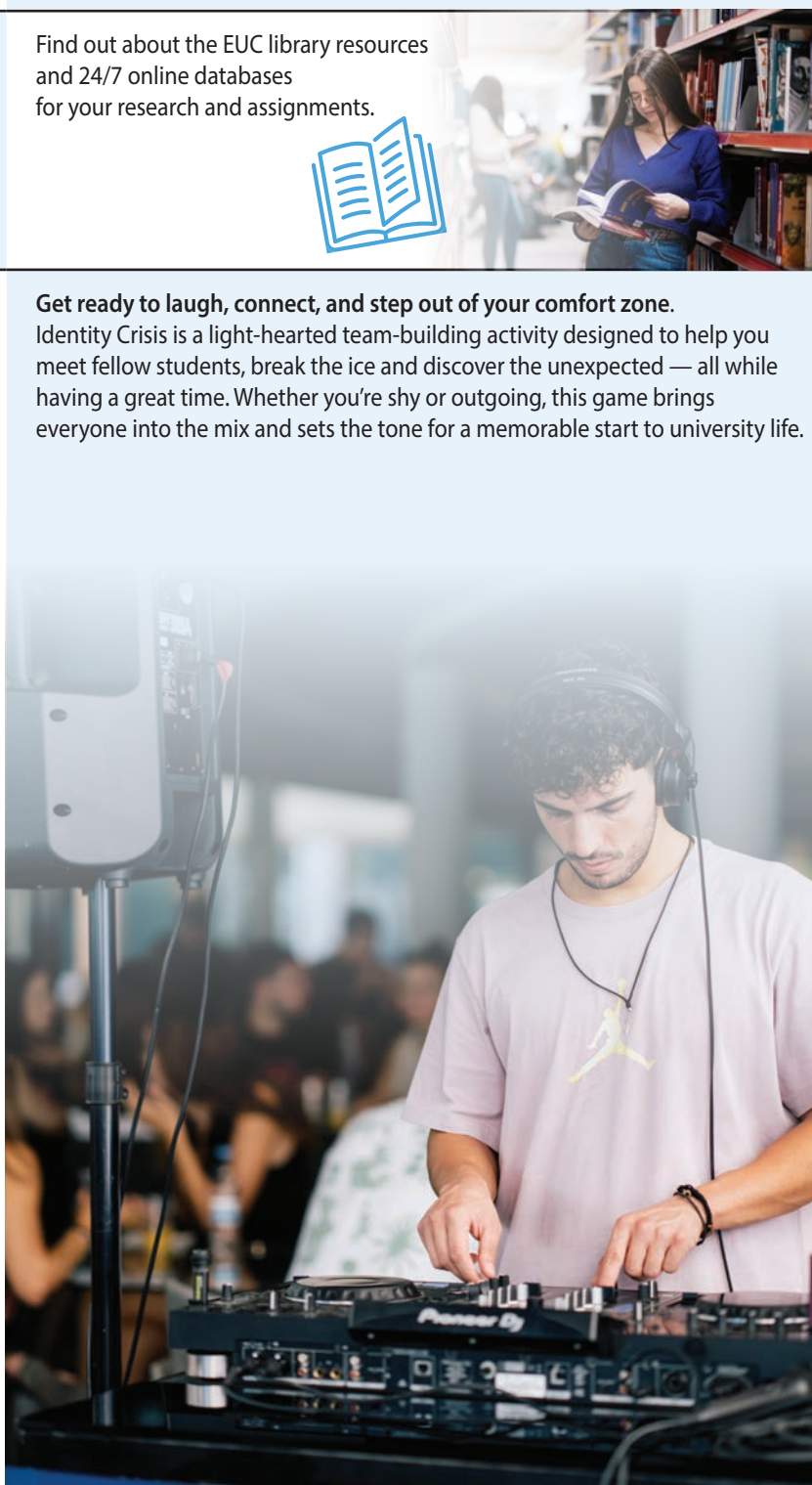
