

This Policy demonstrates the commitment of European University Cyprus to support the principles of environmental sustainability and achieve the objectives set. All relevant environmental processes will be reflected through the activities of students, employees, and stakeholders.

European University Cyprus (EUC) is working towards the reduction of the environmental footprint of its operations by following the principles below, based on the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs):

- Responsible consumption of energy, water, paper, and other resources
- Proper waste disposal management
- Protection of biodiversity within and around the campus physical environment
- Monitoring of environmental aspects and sources within the working environment
- Compliance with local and international environmental laws and regulations

Objectives for the Academic Year 2025–2026

- Installation of a new photovoltaic (PV) system with a total capacity of **30 kWp**.
- Establishment of a formal procedure for the collection and disposal of **electronic waste (e-waste)** through an authorized waste management company.
- Preparation and submission of a **new Energy Audit** for the University's buildings, as required every four years by **Law N.109(I)/2021**.
- Continued implementation of **water and air quality monitoring**, ensuring compliance with applicable legislation within the University premises.
- **Recertification of the University's management system** in accordance with the **ISO 14001:2018** standard.
- Installation of **new recycling waste bins** at the **Dental Clinic**.

The Executive Committee of EUC is committed to the effective implementation of this Policy and has ultimate responsibility for its overall performance by fostering employee engagement, responsibility, and compliance.

This Policy is communicated within the University and is available to the public, students, and all individuals working for, in, or on behalf of the University.
